D&T

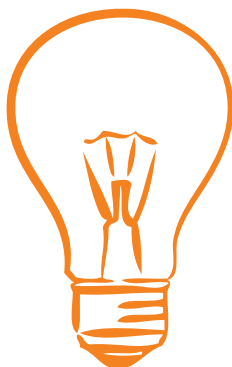
- Pupils could think about where our food comes from and relate this to produce grown in Africa. They could also apply their knowledge of healthy eating in science.
- Pupils could grow their own produce in classrooms or a vegetable plot. Pupils could then use this produce to sell or create home-made treats which could also become part of a fundraising sale.

ENGLISH

- **Stories from other cultures**
Introduce African cultural or traditional tales.
- **Explanatory text**
Use Farm Africa's website to talk about the work we do in eastern Africa.
- **Writing persuasive letters**
Pupils could encourage people to support Farm Africa or come to a fundraising event.

PSHE

- During fundraising for Farm Africa pupils could think about the importance of community and team work.
- Hearing Rose and Kiilu's story can help children to challenge stereotypes.



- **Instruction writing**
Pupils could write instructions on how to grow crops, make healthy recipes or how to organise a fundraising event.

ART

- An art lesson could focus on East African artists or traditional African artwork.

MUSIC

- A music lesson could have a focus on East African music and drumming in particular.
- There is a potential cross over with D&T by making a traditional drum such as Djembe.
